### LIMA & MACHU PICCHU

#### Pre or Post Cruise (4 days, 3 nights)

Overnight in Aguas Calientes. (BL)

**Day 3** – As the sun rises over the mountains, watch the morning mist disappear to reveal this awe-inspiring city. The giant walls, terraces and ramps seem as if they have been cut naturally in the continuous rock escarpments. Return by train to Cuzco. Overnight in Cuzco. (BD)
